

Neath Port Talbot District Sports Council

The Neath Port Talbot District Sports Council was founded in 1996 and is a Voluntary Organization which aims to act as the voice of sport in the locality, promote local sport and provide information, assistance and advice to Sports Clubs, **as well as after school clubs**. Affiliation costs **£10 pa per club**.

The majority of the income from affiliation fees is made available to affiliated clubs by operating an event grant of up to £100 towards trophies for clubs organising tournaments or festivals to which other clubs are invited.

Newly affiliated clubs will have to be in membership for 3 months before they are eligible to apply.

The following benefits are available;

- Acts as the voice of Sport in the locality. Direct contact with the Sport Wales to further discuss any issues.
- Representation on the Celtic Community Leisure Board to pursue any concerns relating to local indoor facility hire. Direct contact with the Local Authority Outdoor Leisure for facilities operated by them.

Provide information to Clubs on issues that may be of interest to them, e.g. available external grants. These are e mailed to clubs.

- A discount on direct debit payments for any member of an affiliated club using **Celtic Leisure In Shape Gyms and Swimming facilities** providing that are signed up to the Direct Debit scheme. Celtic Leisure operate Leisure Centres on behalf of the Local Authority.
- 3 meetings per year to which all affiliated Clubs are invited.
- Provide road shows free of charge to affiliated Clubs on sports related subjects. Previous road shows have included; Risk Assessment in Sports Clubs, Sponsorship, Finding the Funds, Successful Grant Applications, Various aspects of Child Protection, Welfare Officers, Working with Difficult Children, Valuing Volunteers, Disability Issues, Funding and Promoting, Tax Information for Volunteers, Clubs and Sportspersons and School / Club Links.
These road shows demonstrate and assist development and good practice within Clubs.
- Award Service to Sport awards for volunteers who have given outstanding service to their Club and or Sport.
- Contact with AYP officers for junior teams to access a coach or referee from college students to assist with duties should the normal person not be available. As part of their studies, these students are required to put in 100 hours a year community work (assisting in clubs) for their Welsh Bacs and Duke of Ed. awards.
- Advice on funding applications, including Community Chest.
- Arrange first aid and child protection courses.
